Children Health :

Now the covid - 19 hit Thailand for second and third times, especially in the big city. But we are so thankful to God that our District Galayani Vadhana is not effected till now

We have not heard any sickness of our children and staffs, we continue to Thank God for protecting all of our health.

The activities of the children and staffs of HRDC:

On 2nd June, children from Maewae village came to interview -4 children, all of them are from broken family, Their grandparents has been caring them at the village, as they are getting old, they want them to have a better education, but the children could not adjust themselves to stay at the Hostel, living Hostel has no freedom of doing whatever they want. Finally they decided to go back to the village on 20th.June 21, Sunday.



We have started reaching out the children at Dong Sam Muen, but because of the covid - 19, we are not able to gather them yet, so we have them in a small group – writing letter to their sponsor, led by our new co-coordinator, Pratip one of our graduate student.

On 6th June 2021 Sunday, we decided to visit Ho Tae Dae (Kiauphaphet village), They asked me to preach, I did preach to declare the Glory of God, On the way back to Musekee, we visited twins blind boy at Hwuih Ma goo, to talk with their family, about taking them to the blind school. We are so thankful that they agree to let them go to school in Chiangmai.



On 8th.June Tuesday, took the children to Chiangmai to buy school stuffs for school, and also checking Blind school for that they welcome them bring them down.

On 9th.June Wednesday evening, We went to visit Tanachai, and Sanboon's mother and Tam's mother, and meet their new brother who is now 3 months. The next day on 10th.June, Thursday we went to Kat Luang (Shopping center) to buy school uniform, education materials and clothe.

On 13th.June Sunday, Children started coming back, because school is opening on 14th.June 21 Monday, old and new children came in happily.

On 14thJune 21 Monday all the school open, they all enjoy going to school.

On 15thJune Tuesday, we went to Hwuihmagoo under the rain, to pick up Lek from his village, and the next day he was sent to blind school in Chiangmai. We are so thankful to God for giving us a chance to help this precious child Lek to have an education, but his brother do not go with him because his Aunty want him to be with her, hoping that she will let him go one day.



Students arrived on 13th.June to go back to school, This academic year of 2021-2022, It is the first time in 33 years, to have more boys than girls. we have 15 boys and 8 girls to live at the center. We have

been concentrating on the girls for many years, I think now it is time to give chance to boys, train them to be a good leader and help them to be away from drugs . I believe God wants us to build new family and train them to be a responsible father for their children.





We have visited different centers – on 24th June 2021, Thursday. We visited Maenamkhiau, and on 29th Tuesday visited Hwuihpooling and on 30th June 2021 Wednesday, visiting them pray for them and distribute food and school educational material for the children.

On 11th June 2021 Friday, Rev. Thangridema, missionary from Baptist Church of Mizoram, India and his family visited us, it was short but it was so meaningful and courage us,



New staff : WE have been longing for a staff who can help at teaching English and help cooking, Now God has called Mr. E Toe Loe to join our ministry at HRDC center. We are so thankful to God.

COMMUNITY :

The whole community in Musekee including staffs are busy with their rice-field, planting rice, but there is no enough water in the field to plant rice, so many people decided to grow mountain rice on the mountain. Very quiet in the village, and crowded in their rice field. The Karen farmers always help one another to grow rice.

WE are so thankful to God for people to donate for us that we can help churches in this area. Now we are very excited to be able to deliver Hwuihpooling Church Building materials. The road is really bad, we are able to go through only when there is no rain. it will take time to deliver all materials, WE are hoping that the work will be able to start in between the planting and harvesting time.

Myanmar Border situation : No good news of Myanmar war, so many village people still need to live in the caves and in the jungle, Now many young people sacrifice their lives , get military training – with a hope that one day they can help protect their people from the hands of Myanmar. My husband Soradaet and his friends spend most of their times to help encourage those young people at the military camp. and continue to deliver food for the people.

NEEDS : WE need more prayer partner

1. More support for children is needed.
2. The college fund – we are thankful that we have more and more kids who keen to study in the college, Now many families also understand that education can help them prevent the young people from prostitution or exploited.
3. Donation for new buildings, renovating and maintenance. The building are getting old they are not concrete building, build with the local wood, so we always need to maintain the building.
4. Donation for Sustaining project – as we have more students graduating every year, we would like start a big Business center where the villagers can come and sell their product to support their family. And the graduates student can have job for their living.
5. Support the Evangelist – the Evangelist continue to reach people in the village, we are hoping that more people will come to believe Jesus Christ.
6. Donation to support more church building project : We still have one more building Mueng Paeng Church building, they still waiting -
7. Need more support for the Karen people who are living in the cave and jungle because of the war, and also need support young people to be trained - Military Training to protect their own people.
 - a. We are so thankful to the people who send their donation through Handclasp to help build a church at Hwuihpooling, now the rain come and we are not able to deliver the materials for the church building yet, we are waiting a good weather to go to the village.

And Mueng Paeng church members are praying hard for their new building church. Please help pray for them that the Lord will provide soon for them.
